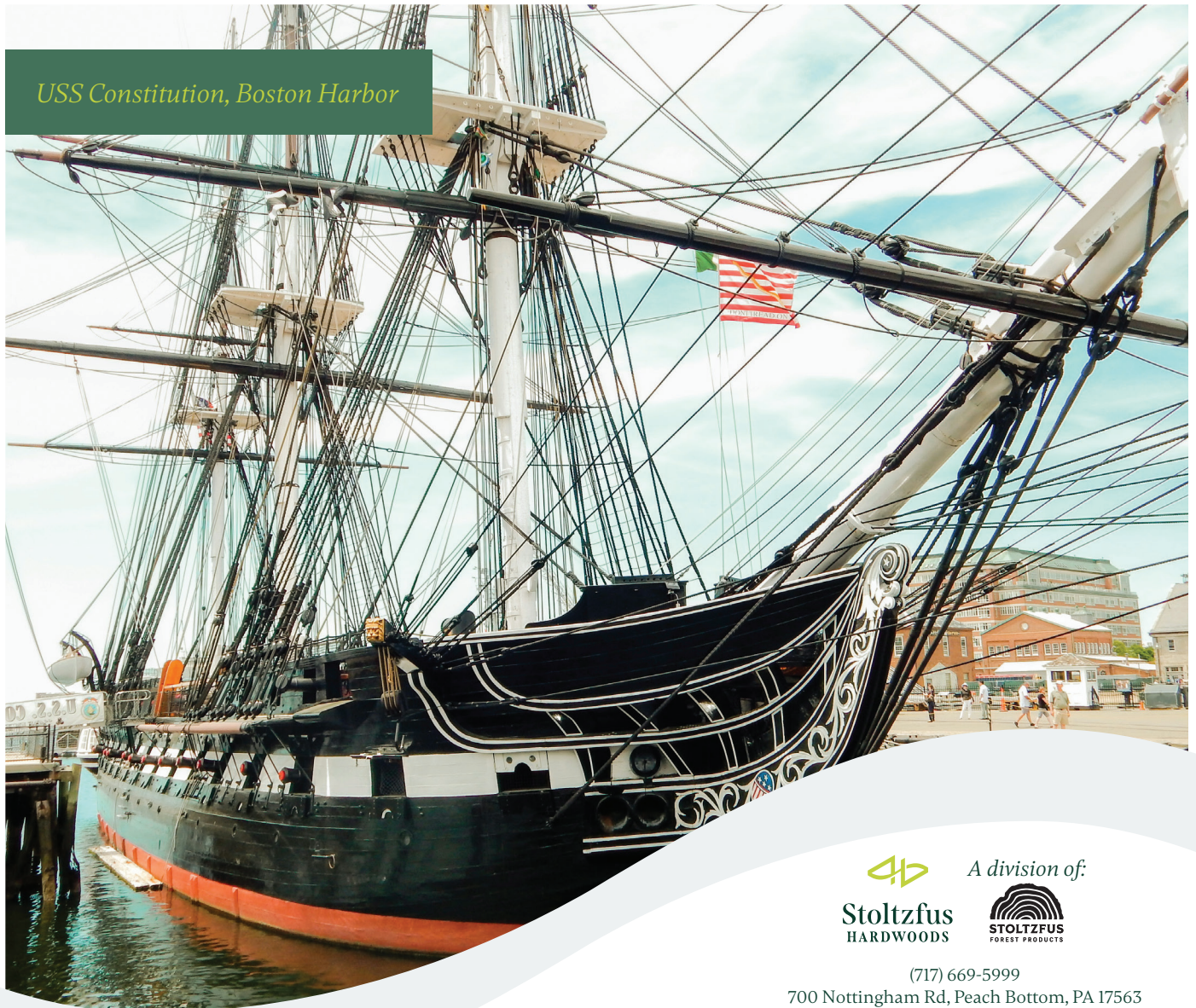


Species Spotlight: White Oak

White oak continues to be one of the most valued hardwoods in the United States. It also has a special place in American history. The USS Constitution was built from a mix of white oak and southern live oak. That ship's toughness became legendary in 1812, when a British cannonball was seen bouncing off its hull, earning it the name "Old Ironsides."
